

RESIDENT ENTRY PROCEDURES

The Town has been diligently working to clear streets and roads so that you can return to inspect your property. We have developed a day pass schedule to allow residents into the town to secure their property. The following guidelines have been established to provide for your safety and to allow the contractors to continue working. Each day by 12 noon we will announce the areas that have been cleared and schedule your day to enter the beach during the hours of 8 am- 3 pm.

RESIDENTS OF THESE AREAS MAY ENTER ON

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2016

- JUNGLE ROAD DOCKSITE ROAD
- LYBRAND STREET YACHT CLUB ROAD
- BAY POINTROAD BIG BAY ROAD
- SCOTT CREEK ROAD

1. YOU MAY ONLY ACCESS YOUR PROPERTY AND MAY NOT VISIT ANY OTHER AREA OR BUILDING.
2. YOU WILL BE ISSUED A DAY PASS AT THE CHECKPOINT AFTER YOU PRODUCE ID SHOWING THE ADDRESS OF YOUR PROPERTY. THIS MAY BE A DRIVERS LICENSE, UTILITY BILL, OR TAX BILL.
3. YOU MAY HAVE TO WADE THROUGH WATER SO DRESS APPROPRIATELY WITH BOOTS, LONG PANTS AND ETC.
4. NO RESOURCES ARE CURRENTLY AVAILABLE. PLAN TO BRING ANY SUPPLIES THAT YOU NEED. WATER, FOOD, AND ETC. NO WATER IS AVAILABLE FOR CLEANING.
5. ANY SPOILED FOOD MUST BE BAGGED AND PLACED IN THE GARBAGE CART AND ROLLED TO THE CURB. DO NOT PLACE IN THE STREET. DO NOT PLACE IN FRONT OF ANY OBJECT THAT WOULD BLOCK THE GARBAGE CONTRACTOR'S EQUIPMENT.
6. A CHART OF HOW TO DISPOSE OF ANY DAMAGED HOUSEHOLD GOODS IS ATTACHED. IT MUST BE STRICTLY FOLLOWED.

MORE MANAGEABLE

▶ Follow these guidelines when putting out your debris to make for a speedier and less costly clean-up.

DO NOT STACK DEBRIS AGAINST


▶ Trees, poles, fire hydrants, and storm drains.

NO SIDEWALK

▶ If you do not have a sidewalk, place debris at the edge of your property before curb.

Any debris placed from the sidewalk toward your property will not be picked up.

VEGETATION DEBRIS

- ▶ Leaves
- ▶ Logs

SPOILED FOOD CONTAMINATED RECYCLBLES

- ▶ Spoiled food items
- ▶ Wet or mildewed newspaper, cardboard, other

Note: Normal household trash will not be picked up with debris.

STRUCTURAL DEBRIS BULKY WASTE

- ▶ Building materials
- ▶ Dry wall
- ▶ Lumber
- ▶ Carpet
- ▶ Furniture
- ▶ Mattresses
- ▶ Plumbing

APPLIANCES

Remove all food and remove or secure doors.

- ▶ Washers, dryers
- ▶ Freezers
- ▶ Air Conditioners
- ▶ Stoves
- ▶ Water Heaters
- ▶ Dishwashers

ELECTRONICS

Remove all data.

- ▶ Radios
- ▶ Stereos
- ▶ DVD players
- ▶ Telephones
- ▶ Other devices

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

- ▶ Oils
- ▶ Batteries
- ▶ Pesticides
- ▶ Oil-based Paints and Stains
- ▶ Cleaning supplies
- ▶ Lawn Chemicals
- ▶ Compressed Gas
