A RESOLUTION OF THE COLLETON COUNTY COUNCIL EXPRESSING ITS INTENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SOUTH CAROLINA ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES PROPERTY AND LIABILITY TRUST

WHEREAS, the South Carolina Association of Counties has established the South Carolina Association of Counties Property and Liability Trust for the purpose of providing property, liability, and related risk management services to participating counties and other eligible governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, participation in the Trust allows counties to pool resources for the effective management of risks and liabilities while promoting sound risk management practices; and

WHEREAS, the Colleton County Council has determined that participation in the South Carolina Association of Counties Property and Liability Trust is in the best interest of Colleton County and its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Colleton County Council, duly assembled, as follows:

1. Intent to Participate: Colleton County hereby expresses its intent to participate in the South Carolina Association of Counties Property and Liability Trust in accordance with the Trust Agreement, Bylaws, and all applicable rules and requirements governing participation.

Authorization: The County Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate Colleton County's participation in the Trust and to take such actions as may be necessary to maintain participation therein.

Compliance: Colleton County agrees to comply with the terms and conditions of participation as established by the South Carolina Association of Counties Property and Liability Trust.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
